our neighbors. Our next camping meeting will be on



Section 2: Personal Development Report (PDR) Instructions

4-H members record their participation and activities in 4-H and outside of 4-H for the current 4-H program year on the Personal Development Report. <u>Items cannot be counted in multiple categories</u> (known as "double-counting"). However, if a member participates in multiple activities during one event, those separate activities may be counted and attendance at the event may be counted.

1. 4-H Projects Completed (Required for a Star Rank)

Purpose: This category records projects a 4-H member has completed.

Example: Member of Beanies for Babies, Where's Mom, Camping, Photography, Goats, Swine, etc.

2. 4-H Project Skill Activities

Purpose: This category records activities where 4-H members either exhibited their 4-H work or demonstrated their knowledge to an audience and/or judge.

Example: Market & Breeding animals shown at fair, anything you entered— Fair, Exhibit Day, Club Fair Booth, National 4-H Week Display, Judging Board Competition, etc.

3. 4-H Events Attended

Purpose: This category records 4-H events, other than 4-H Club and project meetings, that the 4-H member attended during the year.

Example: Bonita Awards Banquet, Round Robin Competition, Ice Cream Social, County Presentation Day, Pizza Night, Exhibit Day, etc.

4. Leadership Development (Required for a Gold or Platinum Star Rank)

Purpose: This category records leadership activities undertaken by the 4-H member.

Example: Club Officer, Member of Executive Board, Project Junior/Teen Leader, Any Committee you served as a chair or member, etc.

5. Citizenship & Community Service (Required for a Star Rank)

Purpose: This category records citizenship and community service activities undertaken by the 4-H member.

Example: Worked at Buyers BBQ, Food Donation, Secret Santa, Toy Drive, Holiday Cards for Soldiers, Pasta Donation, Change for Change, etc.

6. Communication Skills (Required for a Star Rank)

Purpose: This category records communication activities undertaken by the 4-H member.

Example: Any article submitted to the newsletter, any project demo, project reports (different audiences equates a separate record book entry), etc.

7. Honors and Recognition

Purpose: This category records the significant honors and recognition earned by the 4-H member.

Example: Club Gold Record Book, County Medalist Record Book, County Winner Record Book—Gold and Officer books, 100% Attendance, Awards from Fair, Exhibit Day and Project Day, etc.

8. Lifestyle Activities (4-H and Outside of 4-H)

Purpose: This category records lifestyle activities both in and outside of 4-H that the member participated in.

Example: Class Officer, Member of a club not already listed, sports team, church group, youth group, dance, martial arts, music lessons, job, etc.
